



Classical guitarist Christopher Teves has performed throughout the United States as a recitalist and as a soloist with orchestras. Career highlights include performances at the Dame Myra Hess Series in Chicago, the Guitar Foundation of America International Festival in Charleston, the Society of Composers Inc. National Conference in Iowa City, the Piccolo Spoleto Festival, performances in New York, Washington D.C., Pittsburgh, Cincinnati, Memphis, and appearances with orchestras in the Czech Republic, Ohio, South Carolina, and Virginia. His studies include degrees from the University of South Carolina, Cincinnati College-Conservatory of Music and post graduate studies at the Eastman School of Music. He has served on the music faculties of the University of South Carolina, Capital University, Otterbein College, and the Eastman School of Music Community Education Division. He is currently on the music faculty at Charleston Southern University and performs regularly with flutist Tacy Edwards, Chamber Music Charleston, and the North Charleston Pops Orchestra. His discography includes *The Water is Wide* (2005) with flutist Tacy Edwards, *Hauntings* (2004) with the Moravian Philharmonic Orchestra, and his solo CD, *Guitar America* (1999). As a composer and arranger he wrote music for the film short *Dustin and Hoffman* at the Charleston International Film Festival and his orchestral arrangements will be performed by the North Charleston Pops! during the 2014-2015 season.
